This statement is in regards to the purchasing and use of raw materials and the Dodd-Frank Act, specifically section XV.

WCI is committed to ensure the health, safety and well-being of people and the environment worldwide and will continue to practice these principles in our global business. We also expect our suppliers to share this same commitment.
